For decades, the Lakers have been an important part of baseball in the Flathead Valley. While Kalispell now proudly offers high school baseball in the spring, American Legion Baseball continues to play a critical role in summer player development, giving athletes the opportunity to compete at a higher level, face teams from across Montana, surrounding states, and Canada, and prepare for future collegiate or competitive baseball opportunities.

Legion baseball extends the season beyond high school by providing:

- Additional game experience and competitive summer play
- Advanced coaching, skill development, and leadership opportunities
- Exposure to regional and national competition through the American Legion program

Teams across Montana still compete for a state championship, with the champion advancing to regional play and potentially the American Legion World Series in Shelby, North Carolina.

The Kalispell Lakers are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, operated by a volunteer board of community members. Unlike school programs, Legion baseball receives no school funding. Our season is made possible entirely through community support, including corporate sponsorships, fundraising events, donations, and family-paid player fees.

Corporate sponsorships directly help offset the cost of:

- Team travel expenses
- Equipment and uniforms
- Field and facility maintenance
- Coaching and umpire expenses

There are several sponsorship opportunities available. Businesses can participate for as little as \$200, while our Grand Slam sponsorship level is \$2,500. Our most popular option is the \$500 sponsorship, which includes a business banner displayed on the outfield fence at our fields. One hundred percent of all sponsorships goes directly toward reducing player fees, ensuring that any athlete can participate regardless of family income.

Whether it is a family pass, a sponsorship, or another form of support, I am extremely grateful for your consideration. Being part of the Kalispell Lakers allows me to continue developing as a baseball player while also learning responsibility, teamwork, and community involvement. Our program regularly partners with local organizations and businesses on service projects, helping players grow not just as athletes, but as citizens.
